

Legal: Condo Cases

Straight From The Source ***Interview Guidelines***

To participate in the “Straight From The Source” lawyer interview series circulated on-line by the Toronto & Area Chapter of the Canadian Condominium Institute (CCI Toronto), you must meet the following criteria:

1. The case that you discuss must have been decided by a court of law or tribunal.
2. A link must be publicly available to the decision (i.e. via CanLII) which can be circulated with your written interview.
3. You must be listed as counsel in the decision as the purpose of this interview series is to have those directly involved in a case share their insights with respect to it.
4. You must be a member of CCI Toronto.

Limited exceptions may apply at the discretion of CCI Toronto.

Upon meeting the above requirements, you are welcome to complete your answers to the following 6 questions and provide them with your name and link to the case referenced by way of e-mail to info@ccitoronto.org.

Interview Questions

- 1. What was this case about?**
- 2. What required this case to go to Court?**
- 3. What were the main issues before the Court?**
- 4. What were the unique challenges of this case?**
- 5. What can condominiums learn from this case?**
- 6. What was the outcome of this case?**

Please ensure that the total word count of your submission does not exceed 800 words and include a 1-2 line brief biography to include in the circulation of your interview.

We appreciate your contribution, will deem your delivery of your content to be your consent to publish and circulate your interview and retain the right to edit, amend and publish your interview as CCI Toronto sees fit.

A final version of your interview, if selected for circulation, will be provided to you prior to being published.
